

Yamal LNG Ships Third Million Tons of LNG

Moscow, 23 July 2018. OAO Yamal LNG has shipped three million tons of LNG produced at its first LNG train.

Yamal LNG reached the third millionth ton shipped on the 41st cargo loaded from the first LNG train since its launch in December 2017. In July, the summer navigational period commenced on the Northern Sea Route, allowing the Yamal LNG project to ship cargos of LNG using Arc7 ice- class LNG tankers in the Eastern direction to Asian-Pacific countries without ice-breaking support, as well as utilizing LNG carriers with lower ice class designation.

Note

Yamal LNG is constructing a 16.5 mmtpa natural gas liquefaction plant utilizing the hydrocarbon resources of the South-Tambeyskoye field on the Yamal peninsula located in the Arctic territory of the Russian Federation. The first LNG train commenced LNG production in the fourth quarter 2017 with the loading of the inaugural tanker on 8 December 2017. Yamal LNG shareholders include: PAO NOVATEK (50.1%), Total (20%), CNPC (20%), and the Silk Road Fund (9.9%).
